 Not a particular class but a particular school where 8 teachers were involved. The teachers were really motivated. They were participating to the eco-school label, so the Feedu project had really helped them. They used 8 Feedu tools and 3 non Feedu tools. The 8 classes have worked on an exposure about energy, RUE, RES, mobility and climatic changes. They have organized an energy day in their school with the whole pupils, presenting Feedu and non Feedu activities, the exposure and a treasure hunt on energy. They also participated to the environment day of their city, where they had stands showing activities they have done during school year to general public.
